

Port Klang welcomes cruise ship with 3,000 passengers

THE arrival of a cruise ship from Singapore to Port Klang Cruise Terminal after two years was welcomed by tourism industry players in Selangor.

The Royal Caribbean cruise ship, Spectrum of the Seas, carried about 3,000 passengers and around 1,500 crew members.

Tourism Selangor and Port Klang Cruise Terminal Sdn Bhd hosted an event at the cruise terminal to welcome the passengers.

It featured cultural performances by the Selangor State Culture and Arts Department, the provision of a tourist information centre, "canting batik" activities and display of Orang Asli Mah Meri handicraft.

In a statement, Tourism Selangor chief executive officer Azrul Shah Mohamad said before the Covid-19 pandemic, Selangor received more than 500,000 tourists in
